## Setting a Word-Count Goal

Your word-count goal for NaNoWriMo's Young Writers Program is completely unique. You should take into account ..
> your writing experience
> your schedule (how much time you'll realistically be able to spend writing)
> your enthusiasm for the event
Everybody can write a novel in a month, but you might choose to write a novella, a novelette, or short story. ${ }^{1}$
Below, are three recommendations options for each grade level. You might choose a low, middle, or high goal from these suggestions, use ywp.nanowrimo.org/wordcount/goal to estimate a goal unique to you, or select another word count all your own. It's all up to you!

| Grade | Suggested Low Goal | Suggested Middle Goal | Suggested High Goal |

| Kindergarten <br> $5-6$ years | 20 | 100 | 200 |
| $1^{\text {st }}$ grade <br> $6-7$ years | 40 | 150 | 300 |
| $2^{\text {nd }}$ grade <br> $7-8$ years | 100 | 300 | 500 |
| $3^{\text {rd }}$ grade <br> $8-9$ years | 300 | 500 | 800 |
| $4^{\text {th }}$ grade <br> $9-10$ years | 500 | 800 | 1,200 |
| $5^{\text {th }}$ grade <br> $10-11$ years | 800 | 1,200 | 2,000 |
| $6^{\text {th }}$ grade <br> $11-12$ years | 1,200 | 3,000 | 3,000 |
| $7^{\text {th }}$ grade <br> $12-13$ years | 2,000 | 5,000 | 5,000 |
| $8^{\text {th }}$ grade <br> $13-14$ years | 3,000 | 10,000 | 10,000 |
| $9^{\text {th }}$ grade <br> $14-15$ years | 5,000 | 17,000 | 17,000 |
| $10^{\text {th }}$ grade <br> $15-16$ years | 10,000 | 25,000 | 25,000 |
| $11^{\text {th }}$ grade <br> $16-17$ years | 17,000 | 35,000 | 35,000 |
| $12^{\text {th }}$ grade <br> $17-18$ years | 25,000 | 50,000 |  |

- Keep in mind that a word-count goal is a lower threshold, not an upper limit.
- The deadline for changing your word-count goal is 11:59 PM on Thursday, November 19 - before winning starts!
- Winning starts on Friday, November 20. To officially win NaNoWriMo, you must validate that you've reached word count goal online at ywp.nanowrimo.org/oll/my/novel by 11:59 PM on Monday, November 30.
- Based on your account's local time —be sure to set your time zone at ywp.nanowrimo.org/oll/my/settings

[^0]:    ${ }^{1}$ While novels can vary tremendously in length, a work of fiction under 7,500 words is generally classed as a short story. If you write up to 17,500 words, you can call it a novelette. If you get up to 40,000 words, it's a novella. If you get beyond that, it's a novel.
